
Family comes first.

## **Budget update**

#### TSD will

- Overrun Operations Labor budget by \$100+k in FY24
  - We're spending too much on Operations codes (20.37.\*)
  - Projects, projects! Includes SPS
- M&S/Travel budget needs to cover that overrun
  - Right now, let's not spend money on things we don't need right now
  - We might be able to loosen the reins
- SPS Budget is healthy
  - Will likely be ending a few spares projects of NuMI
    - Decisions not approved yet
  - Will likely shift to LBNF spares next year

- Vladimir Sidorov: The last marble plates were installed on the Booster Collimator in MAB today. It includes four primary jaws, and two secondary collimation units. It will be disassembled and installed in the Booster Long 8 section this summer. It is 13.5 ft long, 7.3 ft tall, and 4.3 ft wide, and weighs about 100k lbs.
