General Status

- We are currently running 5 elogs:
 - MICE (18), Decay Solenoid (3), LH2System (0), R9 (4) & SS-testing (19)
- These are running / synchronized between several machines:
 - micewww (main server)
 - hep1nv156 (micewww replacement, in test)
 - miceserv1 (micenet.rl.ac.uk backup, brand new)

Proposed Change: MICE Log

- We currently have 7 categories:
 - Routine, **Warning, Error, Problem Fixed,** Reference, Calibration, Config. Change
 - When searching, you really want to combine these 3.
- Propose a “Warning/Error” category, with 3 sub-categories:
 - Will not break past data.
 - Could be edited in place, to match new structure, for future searches.
