  - Folks using older ifdhc releases (which is most of them) should set SAM\_WEB\_BASE\_URL and IFDH\_BASE\_URI in their jobs, etc. <u>before Brandon turns off</u> samweb forwarder on October 16th

  - 1. Upgrade Public dCache instance to version 9.2 from 8.2. The highlighted updates between 8.2 and 9.2 are:
  - **Improve concurrent file create rate in a single directory**
  - Performance improvements for the concurrent directory creation and removal
  - dCache now supports Java 17 as its platform ►
