

The Scientist Advisory Council includes about 15 scientists from across the organization, with different experience levels. The representing members are tasked with engaging in transparent and inclusive discussions about short- and long-term plans for Fermilab's research program. The council also addresses matters related to the careers and professional development of the laboratory's scientific staff and meets regularly with the lab director.

Council members serve two-year terms, with half of them rotating out each year. In early September, the laboratory director invites nominations via the *all-scientists* distribution list – self-nominations are also accepted. The current council, with input from the laboratory director, selects new members with terms beginning Oct. 1, ensuring representation from each scientific organizational unit.
