This December's Meeting


- As usual it was hard to find a day/time when most of us could meet.

- Term limits: Natalie and Jon proposed a limit of 6 years, with either 2 terms of 3 years, or 3 terms of 2 years, or no limits at all.

Spokesperson Nomination Limits Vote Results


How many nominations for Spokesperson may a board member submit? 23 responses




Spokesperson Term Limits Vote Results


