**Due October 7, 2014**

Proceedings for the Neutrino 2014 Conference will be published by the American Institute of Physics Conference Proceedings (AIPCP). The proceedings will be comprised of written contributions for each of the oral presentations. Poster presentation titles and presenters will be listed. Written contributions should be submitted by October 7, 2014 (4 months after the end of the conference). Edited versions will then be transmitted to the publishers. The Proceedings will appear about six months after the end of the conference in an AIPCP open access web site. This site will be accessible to anyone in perpetuity.

For those who desire a printed version of the Proceedings, bound copies may be ordered in anticipation of a single printing run. The cost of the printed version of the Proceedings will be \$75 including shipping. This cost was not included in the conference registration fee, it is an option. Orders must be placed before November 1, 2014.
