

#### **ELBNF** is born

### (and might change name soon!)

A merger of all previous efforts and any other interested parties to build, operate, exploit

- a (staged) 40 Kt LAr detector, at the SURF site,
  1300 Km from FNAL
- An high granularity/high precision near detector

exposed to a 1.2 MW, tunable  $\nu$  beam produced by the PIP-II upgrade at FNAL by 2024, evolving to a power of 2.3 MW by  $\sim$  2030.

### Goals of this meeting

- Agree on a minimal level of organization and governance
- Set a prioritized roadmap to the CDR
- Launch spokesperson selection process
- Form the relevant Working Groups to make progress before the full organization is in place, and to provide a way for individuals/groups to get involved in R&D efforts, CDR writing and other collaboration activities
- Define dates of next meetings

## First IB Meeting

Discussion of the White Paper on International Governance (WLIG) prepared by a committee chaired by Joe Lykken, (available at <a href="https://indico.fnal.gov/getFile.py/access?">https://indico.fnal.gov/getFile.py/access?</a> resId=0&materialId=0&confld=9209)

The WLIG was endorsed by the IB with no apparent opposition.

#### Memorandum of Collaboration

The Memorandum of Collaboration, prepared by a subcommittee of the iIEB chaired by Chang Kee Jung and available at <a href="https://indico.fnal.gov/internalPage.py?pageId=2&confId=9209">https://indico.fnal.gov/internalPage.py?pageId=2&confId=9209</a>

Question: Do people sign the MOC? Answer: No. It is not an MOU nor a legal document. The collaboration will be built from institutions that sign the LOI.

There was an issue raised about the definition of an experimental physicist. After an extended discussion, a motion was made to clarify by adding language to "a faculty member or equivalent" to be "who makes a contribution to the experiment".

That motion was passed.

The vote to adopt the MOC was passed **apparently unanimously.** 

Formation of co-Spokespersons election committee (SEC)

This will be formed by 3 people.

- 28 Jan Wednesday circulate list of committee; IB should endorse
- SEC will ask for spokesperson nominations from IB members and collect names by Sunday 1 February and stay open for one week, no later than 8 February
- The committee meets, checks with nominees within 5 days by Friday 13 February
- Friday 27 February the nominees post statements/ bios
- Voting 27 Feb to 6 March, SEC announces 7 March
