### What we wanted

- We wanted a platform that would be easily searchable, somewhat informal and allowed easy and quick exchange of information.
- PhpBB (open source) provides most of the functionality:
  - Can divide conversation into subforums/topics
  - Robust search function
  - Formatting options to ease posting code.
  - The user can tailor the level of her/his participation:
    - Notification by chat
    - RSS feed
    - Daily or weekly mail digests
    - Visiting the page.




# But we already have "X", why do we need a forum?

- On MicroBooNE we have many ways of exchanging information, but none of them has all of the functionalities we'd like:
  - Skype chat: Fast, but difficult to find archives –
     Questions may repeat given enough time.
  - Listserv mailing lists: search function is not good.
  - DocDB no way to comment/reply quickly/ask questions
  - E-log no easy structuring into topics.



- You need to be approved and added to a relevant group to see anything.
- Groups have different levels of access, i.e. whole parts of forum can be made invisible based on group privileges.







## Other details

- A user can set their own email digest, RSS feed, or jabber chat notification (gchat works, hangouts had problems – may need to debug)
- The uboone\_analysis\_tools and uboone\_rd list had daily digests that were sent at 5pm every day if there was activity in their respective subforums.
  - Never got email reply to work this would be extremely useful to get more people involved.
- Relatively easy to add new forums.
- Possible to extend functionality lots of phpBB modules available (e.g. stats and email digests).



## Path Forward

- Forum reinstalled from backups on dedicated server in Manchester.
- Running version phpBB 3.0.12 → 3.1 available, but upgrade seems painful.
- This can then be connected back to larforum.org (FNAL now owns domain name)
- For this to be successful it will be crucial to get experts and "citizen-experts" involved (we have had success with this) in order to reach critical mass.
- More admins/moderators needed as well.
- Do we try to keep it informal or not?



## Conclusions

- Setting up an inter-experiment forum driven by the users has the potential of strengthening the community part of LarSoft project.
- It will allow building a knowledge base of existing problems which will save time in the future.
- It should soften the learning curve of LArSoft for people offsite.
- PhpBB is an open-source way of doing this it's not perfect but it has most of the functionality.
- The server is working, we can try to get the summer students involved to gain critical mass?
