Authorea in a nutshell



- ❑ **Write research papers in your web browser**
 - ◆ **Intuitive**
 - Write in LaTeX, without the compilation step
 - Drag and drop figures (png, gif, pdf, ...)
 - (Almost) automatic reference system
 - ◆ **Fully interactive**
 - Several collaborators can edit simultaneously different paragraphs
 - ◆ **Fully shared**
 - Your collaborators can see your changes on their browser and react immediately
 - ◆ **Fully collaborative**
 - Comments can be added, included, answered, ...
 - ◆ **Publication-quality visualization**
 - Many journal styles available for publication
 - ◆ **Robust versioning system (GIT)**
 - Keep the history of your changes
 - Allows you to roll back to an earlier version
 - ◆ **Efficient feedback system and quick bug fixes**

Authorea in a nutshell



□ Write research papers in your web browser

◆ Intuitive

- Write in LaTeX, without the compilation step
- Drag and drop figures (png, gif, pdf, ...)

◆ Fully shared

- Your collaborators can see your work in their browser and react immediately

◆ Fully collaborative

- Comments, discussions, answers, ...

◆ Public

- Your work is available for publication

- Version control system (GIT)

- History of your changes

- Ability to roll back to an earlier version

◆ Instant feedback system and quick bug fixes

□ Getting started

- ◆ Create an article, add a title, an abstract, a section, a co-author ...
 - And experience interactivity and shared collaboration
- ◆ Macros; Equations.
- ◆ Figure drag-and-drop; Tables.
- ◆ Add a reference.
 - From the doi number, e.g., [10.1103/PhysRevLett.108.261801](https://doi.org/10.1103/PhysRevLett.108.261801)
 - From the arXiv number, e.g., 1203.3456 : see <http://www.crcg.de/arXivToBibTeX/>
- ◆ Make a comment.
- ◆ Collaborators and author list.
- ◆ Find past mistakes (and the culprit!), and fix them.
- ◆ Produce an *almost* publication-ready pdf.
- ◆ Export a full article in a directory.
