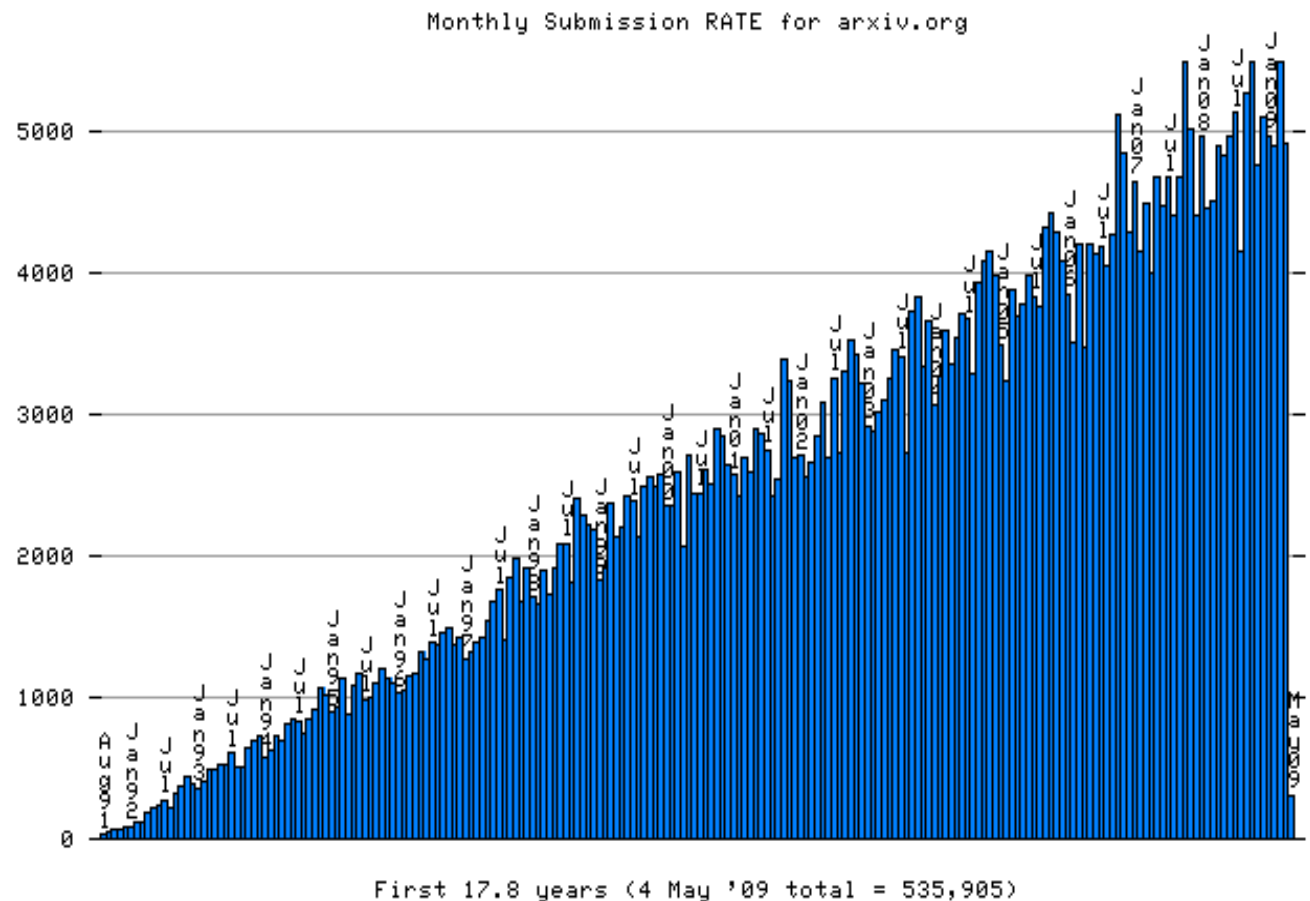

- Rate graph ***still*** showing linear increase

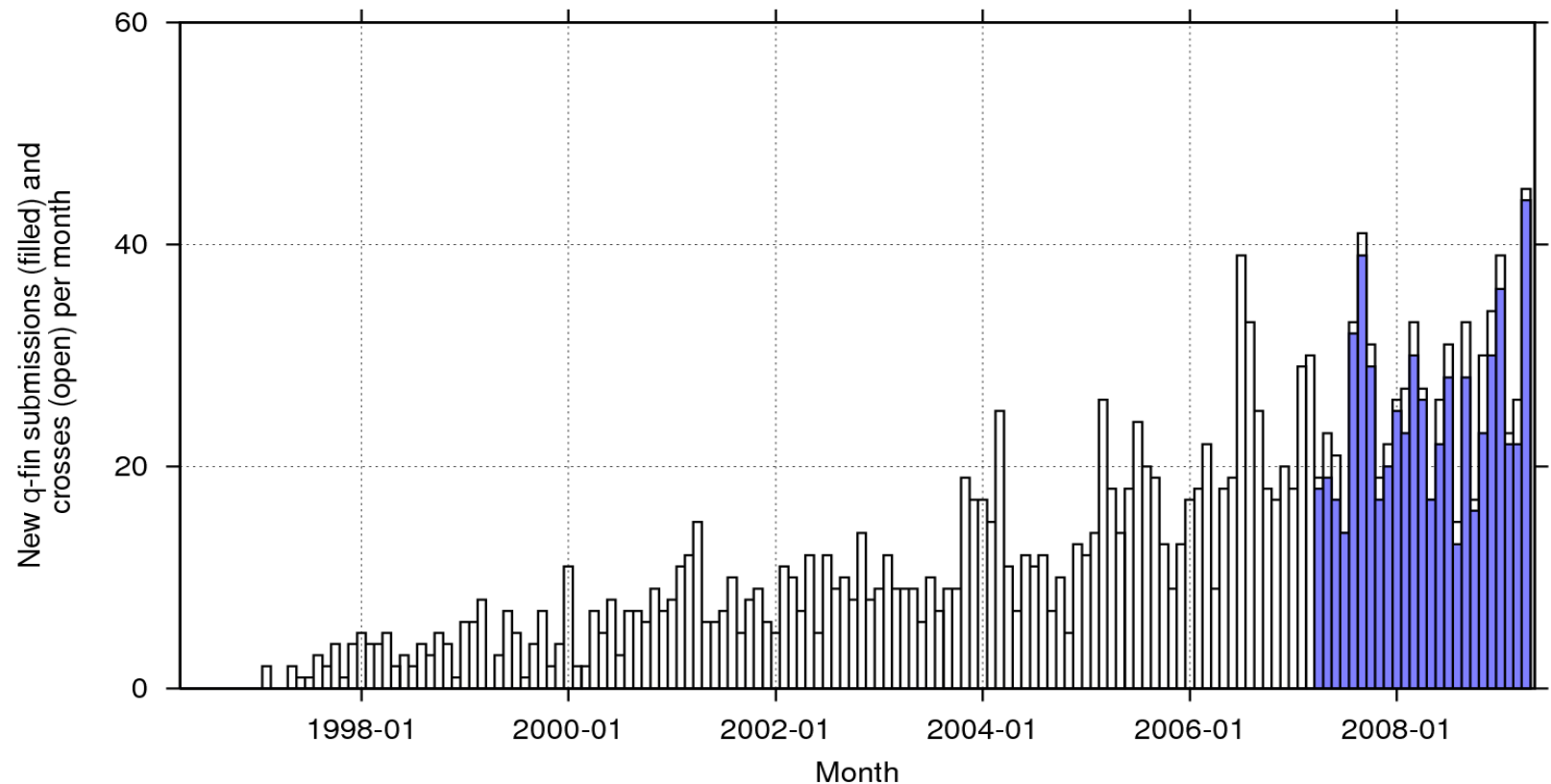


Subject area changes

- Created q-fin Dec 2008, preseeded with 1700 existing submissions, 7 sub-categories
- Content had been going to physics, cond-mat, nlin, math

arXiv API

- <http://arxiv.org/api>
 - inspired by NCBI Entrez but simpler
 - simple query syntax (GET or POST)
 - search + date/update + similarity
 - Atom responses
- Online since December 2007
- Some interesting uses

Support for DOCX

- MS funded work
- Have web service to do
 - DOCX validation
 - DOCX -> PDF
 - DOCX -> plain text
- Will store both DOCX and processed PDF
- Intend to support ODF in similar way

Automated ingest / SWORD

- Project with Microsoft CMT team
- Automate upload of conference proceedings
- Especially important in CS
- Will promote to other conference management systems
- Working on support for notion of collection (a proceedings, an issue etc.)

New submission system

- New programmer (Gerda Shank) working on complete rewrite of submission system
- Upload document first so can plug in metadata extraction and classification tools
- Will put online with “pending” queue
- Expected by end 2008
